Hygiene Measures on Site:

- Regular Hand Washing will be enforced—After every activity, toilet visit, snack and lunch. This will
 include both children and 360 coaches
- Alcohol based Sanitiser will be available on all 360 Camp Front Desks
- Department of Education and Public Health England Advice Posters will be prominently displayed at all sites
- All activities will be held in outdoor spaces unless extreme adverse weather, including snack breaks and lunches. 2m social distancing policy will be adhered to at all times.
- Extra sanitising of tables, chairs, sports equipment and contact points such as door handles, taps and toilets
