

Urgent call for Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) for Surrey's frontline workers - can you help?

We are appealing to businesses and other organisations who may be able to donate essential PPE equipment for frontline workers including care home workers, social workers and volunteers who are helping vulnerable people.

As the nation faces unprecedented demand for PPE, there is a very limited supply coming into the county at the moment with understandably hospitals being prioritised, but we need to improve this situation for other frontline workers. If you have any of the following items that you do not need for your own use, we would be very grateful for donations as soon as possible.

Items urgently required

- Eye protection EN166:2001 Frame Marking: 3
- Hand sanitiser gel (greater than 60% alcohol)
- Disposable overshoes CE marked
- Disposable overalls CE marked
- Disposable plastic apron (single use)
- Disposable gloves (single use) EN:374/5 (Viral protection)/nitrile purple/ nitrile blue
- Fluid repellent surgical mask (single use) Type 11R medical use
- Drager dust masks
- Hand soap
- Surface Cleanser Spray
- Universal Cleaner
- Cleaning cloths
- Disinfectant
- Blue Wiper Roll
- Industrial Cleaning Wipes (excess of 60% alcohol or a disinfectant contained within it)
- Jumbo Toilet Roll
- Paper Hand Towel
