Sporting Talks

Over the last two weeks we have had two excellent talks from sportsmen. Toby Hessian (father of Phoebe and Tommy) spoke at Assembly about his rowing career. His achievements are considerable and include: representing Great Britain for nine years; five time world champion lightweight rower in fours and eights; first ever Junior world Champion for Great Britain in fours; five times Henley winner; twice European champion; five times National Champion; Henley Course Record Holder; World fastest time in 1991 at the Vienna World Championships and in 1994 at the Indianapolis World Championships; first ever lightweight four to break six minutes for 2000 metres. He gave a brilliant account of the Nottingham County lightweights' re-row against Harvard University at Henley in 1989, it was an inspiring story of a famous rowing triumph.

John Hoskison, former European Tour Golf professional, told the story of his career and the way he over-turned shyness and nervousness to compete in the Open at Royal Birkdale. The message was clear: everyone can learn from their mistakes. The boys and girls listened keenly and attentively.
