Yesterday we heard that all 18 of our Year 8 Common Entrance candidates passed their exams into their first choice schools. Details are given below. It is particularly pleasing to note that of 186 papers sat, no less than 82 of them (44% of the total) were awarded A grades. These results, taken together with the six academic scholarships previously announced, confirm Hall Grove's position as one of the top performing prep schools in the country. Congratulations to all the boys and girls, to their parents and to the teaching staff who have prepared them so thoroughly.
