What a tremendous week of Olympic activity we have enjoyed since last Saturday's athletics finals. The highlights have been talks from three Olympian athletes representing athletics (Hayley Tullett), swimming (Christal Clashing O'Reilly) and synchronised swimming (Louise Woolley), and a quite inspirational talk by Diana Mann on the Paralympics. Diana, as a talented 25 year old, went down overnight with the dreadful disease meningitis just five years ago at a time when her life seemed to be going perfectly. She was in a deep coma for five weeks, had both legs amputated and has had to endure major tissue reconstruction. Amazingly she describes herself as lucky, has re-built her life and has ambitions to continue her passions of skiing, riding and running. Diana will be presenting the Paralympics for Channel 4 this Summer - do watch out for her.

Other events have included a Year 5 gymnastics display, Year 8 tetrathlon, synchronised swimming in the school pool, volleyball and blind football. In keeping with the Olympic ideal there have been cultural events too: a large art display, the building of an Olympic village from 100,000 lego pieces, African drumming and our own Choristers have just returned from four days in Barcelona, host of the 1992 Olympics.

Our Olympic Sports Day tomorrow will showcase the school's athletic, sporting and cultural achievements. We are very much looking forward to a great day; do join us for the Olympic Barbecue and an Olympic Pimm's at the end!

Olympic Sports Day - Saturday 30th June

This is our major social function of the school year and we trust that all will show due respect for the occasion by observing the dress code which was given in last week's newsletter. Timings for the day are as follows:
