IAPS Inland Sailing Champions

Competing in a fleet of 44 boats they raced against a cross-section of Prep Schools from around the country in Laser Picos. The boys competed as a new team not having sailed together before the event and neither of them having sailed in Laser Pico dinghies previously. They came second in the first race and went on to win all three of the following races and, with one discard, finished in 1st place. Prizes for finishing 1st overall and 1st in the U13 category were presented by the Chairman of IAPS Sports Committee and Headmaster of Shrewsbury House, Kevin Noble.
