This is an opportunity to contribute views and opinions to the Headmaster and senior staff on a range of school issues, and to consider aspects of the school's future development. Termly Fees 2014/2015

The new termly fees for the academic year 2014/2015 are now on the school website. There has been a general increase of just under 3% with a larger increase for boarding fees to reflect better the cost of running this department. As always we strive to run the school as economically as possible.

Trial of Biometric Registration

We are considering the trial of a new fingerprint 'biometric' registration system that would operate during lunch in the dining room after half term. Due to the many lessons, activities and events that run during the normal school day, this proposed system will help to make school registration at lunch time more efficient for both pupils and staff. We have reviewed several registration systems, including the use of ID cards, but, after consideration and consultation, feel that this registration system will best fit Hall Grove. Indeed, many schools are turning to this technology for pupil registration. Should the trial be successful, this technology will be implemented from September 2014 for children in Years 3 and up. Pre-Prep will not take part in the trial or scheme should it be adopted from September 2014. The 'biometric' identification system uses the finger and its image to uniquely identify each student. Each student has his or her fingerprint registered, which will then be translated to a unique identification code, which is entered into the system. The image of the fingerprint is not recorded or stored and all data is held securely. A ClarionCall will be sent out next week with more information on the trial, technology and include an online permission form for you to complete for your child to take part in this trial.
