In an attempt to improve the flow of traffic at the 1700 -1715 collections, Year 6 pupils will be walked up to the new viewing shelters by the tennis courts at 1700 and will wait for cars there. Matrons' Note

Hand, Foot and Mouth Disease

There has been a case of hand, foot and mouth disease in Pre-Prep. We would like to reassure parents that this is a common viral infection that affects young children and presents as a cold with cough, non-itchy rash to hands and feet, temperature and mouth ulcers. The child will get better on their own without treatment and symptoms normally pass within 7 days. The advice is to keep your child comfortable at home until they are feeling well enough to return to school.

Application for Authorised Absence

With the long school holidays we do not advocate taking children out of school during term time. However, we do recognise that there are sometimes exceptional circumstances which necessitate this. All applications for authorised absence must be in writing and with as much notice as possible, using a form now available on the website (under the 'Parents' tab), or from the School Office. The Headmaster will consider all applications, bearing in mind the child's school attendance throughout the year, as well as the reason for the request. If the Headmaster does not authorise the request a reason will be given. We are obliged to inform the Local Education Authority of any concerning levels of absence.
