This was over 9 holes on a narrow, tricky course with heavy rough – the boys acquitted themselves brilliantly and won by a handsome 10 shots! It was extremely impressive to watch and the team spirit was excellent. Well done boys.

The Rookie Tour is a junior tour for any junior golfers with a handicap, and Hall Grove won two age groups last Sunday at Milford Golf Club. Rocky Chapman shot 77 (Par 68) and won the U12 category and Shergo Kurdi shot 70 (Par 69) and won the U14 category. Well done Rocky and Shergo.
